Detail: Acoustic Green BarrierTM in living Willow, 50m x 2.5m high.

Objective: To reduce heavy motorway traffic noise close to the village of

Gartcosh.

Constr. Date: Spring 2004

The Green BarrierTM, attractive and of natural appearance, was chosen as the most appropriate acoustic barrier to blend in with surroundings adjacent to a new housing development and busy intersection.



The busy M73 motorway runs alongside the village. Noise levels were considerable before erection of the Acoustic Green BarrierTM.



The Rock Delta core provides the sound absorption, giving an 11db reduction in noise.



The Green Barrier™ will soon start to grow and form a living acoustic screen, which is environmentally friendly and pleasing to the eye.



The Green BarrierTM – able to be installed and accommodate undulation and a degree of slope, whilst remaining tidy. The barrier shown, 3 months after planting.
